Feeder kits come flat

VISITORS to Farm World next week will be among the first to see the new Advantage Feeders, which come in a flat pack for easy transportation.

The feeders are the result of more than 12 months' work by Gerard Roney, who was raised on a sheep and cropping farm at Axedale, in central Victoria.

Growing up on a farm, plus a stint of prime lamb production in 2005, has meant Gerard has seen the issue of stock feeding up close.

His feeders come in two types: hay feeders and lick feeders.

The hay feeders have an assisted loading system — there is no longer the need for a front-end loader to lift the bale.

The lick feeders come in two sizes — 27 and 38 bags, with the larger unit also suitable for cattle.

These are made of galvanised steel and have a special adjustment system that gives farmers more control over how much feed to deliver.

These adjusters are easily removed, which helps when grain and pellet flow gets clogged through rain and excess saliva.

The unusual shape of the feeder offers weather protection, with the sides preventing rain mixing with the feed.

Prices run as follows: the round roll hay feeder costs \$506, the double

round roll/large square feeder \$880, the 27-bag (3.1 cubic metre) lick feeder \$1342 and the 38-bag (4.5 cubic metre) version \$1925.
